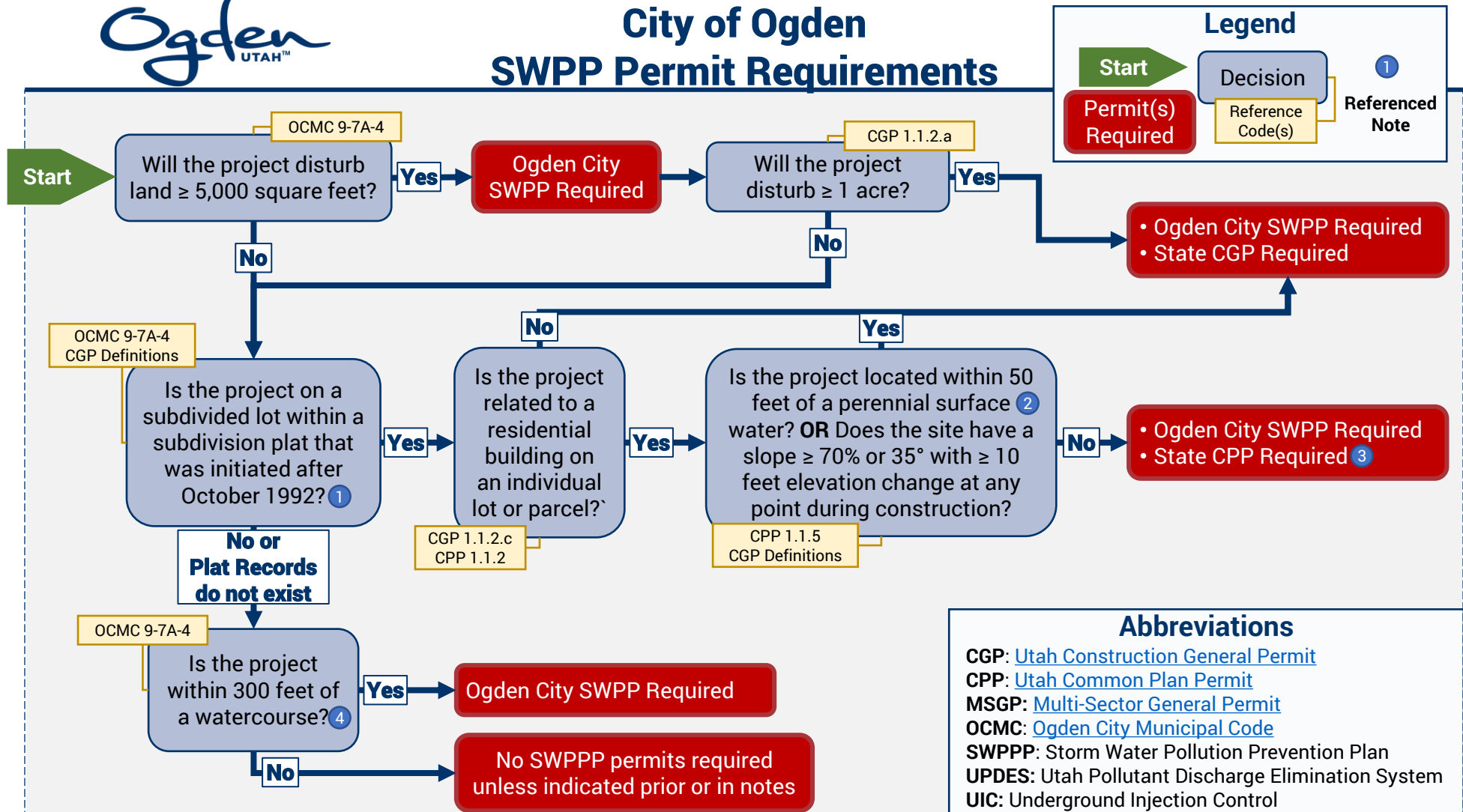




# City of Ogden SWPP Permit Requirements



## Referenced Notes

- 1 Subdivision Plat initiation dates for parcels within Ogden City can typically be found through [Weber County Geo-Gizmo](#).
- 2 Surface water is defined as all open water bodies, streams, lakes, ponds, marshes, wetlands, watercourses, waterways, springs, drainage systems, and all other bodies or accumulations of water on the surface only. Surface water is visible water, standing or flowing, above the surface of the ground.
- 3 A CPP may not be required if the CPP has already been fulfilled (e.g., All lots on the plat have been developed after the plat initiation date).
- 4 A watercourse is any natural or improved stream, river, creek, ditch, channel, canal, conduit, gutter, culvert, drain, gully, swale, or wash in which waters flow either continuously or intermittently.

## General Notes

All demolition projects require an Ogden City SWPP Permit regardless of site size.

All sites shall be assessed for other permits potentially required (MSGP, Dewatering, UIC, etc.) which are not addressed in this flow chart.

All sites shall be compliant with local, State, and Federal storm water regulations regardless of whether a SWPP Permit is required for the project.

Any site subject to a UPDES storm water discharge permit (CGP, CPP, MSGP, etc.) shall provide proof of compliance with such permit to Ogden City.
