This warehouse was one of many permanent brick warehouses to be built in the Defense Depot Ogden (DDO). These were the first buildings to be approved once the rail links were established in 1941. (Any one of the 10 buildings still existing in their original form will count.)

774 W 200 N or other

Built in 1942






This three-story, masonry building was one of the few hotels that Black Americans could stay due to segregation and the lack of equal housing at the time. During World War II, one of the rooms was used as an office for the Black American soldiers in the military police.

2522 Wall Avenue

Built in 1914






This Victorian Gothic brick building was built as a Church in 1905 and was once the location of post 9 for the American Legion.

Built in 1905



This public building with its tiled roof, & detailed brickwork, was one of the main hubs in Utah for the arrival & departure of soldiers during WWII.

2501 Wall Avenue

Built in 1924



This Victorian Eclectic/Queen Anne style home was owned by Robert H Hinckley. Hinckley co-founded the Utah Pacific Airways and started the Civilian Pilot Training Program (CPTP) which trained more than 80,000 pilots, many of which served in World War II.

2560 Jefferson Avenue

Built in 1898



Built to help with the WWII efforts, this 2-story concrete block warehouse located in the DDO is still used for general military today.

269 Defense Depot Maintenance Shop
Approximately 425 N 600 W





This grand art deco building provided defense work training before and during WWII. Funds from the Lanham Act, which were given to communities strained by war industries, went to enlarge the shops at this building.

2828 Harrison Boulevard

Built in 1937



The front porch of this two and one-half story home was made into living space at the beginning of WWII when the home was converted to apartments to help with the housing shortage of that time.

505 27th Street

Built in 1900





This WWII Cottage/Minimal Traditional brick home has a gabled roof and a small, rectangular floor plan. It is a perfect representation of the many WWII Cottages built on the block.

Wollaston House
1153 20th Street

Built in 1941



This military warehouse has exterior walls that are clad with vertical ribbed steel siding with sections of exposed structural concrete. Located in the DDO it was one of five warehouses and contributed to the DDO's capability of shipping 200 boxcars worth of supplies per day.
